- (2) AUTHORIZES THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER OR THE ASSISTANT EXECUTIVE OFFICER, ON THE BASIS OF THIS LETERMINATION, TO EXECUTE APPROPRIATE WRITTEN INSTRUMENTS REQUIRING THAT ADJUSTMENTS TO EXISTING ACCOUNTS ON THE WORK CONSIDERED HEREIN BE MADE IN FAVOR OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA OR THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO FINALLY CLOSE SUCH ACCOUNTS.

WO-401, No prior approval. By Supplementary Decree and Order No. 649466, the Superior Court of the State of California decreed that the Commission retroactively may approve subsidence expenditures disbursed by the City of Long Beach from April 1, 1956, through July 5, 1956.

(1) That the amounts, if any, to be allowed ultimately as subsidence costs, deductible under Section 5(a) of Ch: 29/56, 1st E.S., will be determined by the Commission upon an engineering review and final audit subsequent to the time when the work is completed.

(2) That the work conform in essential details to the plans and background material submitted.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION: (1) DETERMINE THAT THE SUBSIDENCE COSTS DEDUCTIBLE FROM THE OIL REVENUE PAYABLE TO THE STATE UNDER PROVISIONS OF SECTION 5(a)(1) OF CHAPTER 29, STATUTES OF 1956, 1ST E.S., FOR PORT OF LONG BEACH AUTHORIZED FUND EXPENDITURES NUMBERS 539 AND 684 AND WORK ORDER NUMBER 401 ARE AS SHOWN ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED HERETO; AND (2) AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTIVE OFFICER OR THE ASSISTANT EXECUTIVE OFFICER, ON THE BASIS OF THIS DETERMINATION, TO EXECUTE APPRO-PRIATE WRITTEN INSTRUMENTS REQUIRING THAT ADJUSTMENTS TO EXISTING ACCOUNTS ON THE WORK CONSIDERED HEREIN BE MADE IN FAVOR OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA OR THE CITY OF LONG BEACH AS MAY BE NECESSARY TO FINALLY CLOSE SUCH ACCOUNTS.
