4. PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT, SUBMERGED LAND, SACRAMENTO RIVER, YOLO COUNTY;
COUNTY OF YOLO - W.O. N-0036, P.R.C. 3899.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 4 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES THE ISSUANCE TO THE COUNTY OF YOLO OF A 49-YEAR PERMIT FROM JANUARY 26, 1968, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC USE AND BENEFIT, FOR OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF A FLOAT ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF; PROVIDED THAT THE PERMIT SHALL TERMINATE IN THE EVENT A MONETARY CHARGE IS MADE FOR PUBLIC ACCESS AND USE OF THE FACILITY.

PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT

APPLICANT: County of Yolo

LOCATION: An 0.6-acre parcel of submerged land in the Sacramento River, 2.5 miles downstream from Clarksburg, Yolo County

PROPOSED USE: The erection and operation of a 6 x 12-foot float to be used in connection with a fishing-access area

TERMS: 49 years, from January 26, 1968

CONSIDERATION: No charge. The public use and benefit. To apply only for as long as public use and access is free.

PREREQUISITE ITEMS:

U.S.A. Corps of Engineers Permit issued
Applicant is lessee or permittee of upland

Legal description

A parcel of submerged land situate, lying and being in Township 6 North, Range 4 East, M.D.B. & M., County of Yolo, State of California, more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the centerline of County Road No. 140 of Yolo County at Station 142+00 (as per the Deed dated January 24, 1958, recorded in Book 538, page 388, Official Records of Yolo County), which station bears the following courses and distances from the southwest corner of Swamp Land Survey No. 756 of said Yolo County: South 74° 20' East, 2605 feet to the intersection of the centerline of said County Road and the South line of said Swamp Land Survey; thence North 24° 20' East, 558 feet; thence North 42° 48' East, 520 feet to said Station 142+00 of said County Road; thence South 82° 00' East, 68.59 feet; North 52° 36' East, 85.00 feet; South 34° 55' East, 65 feet, more or less, to the mean high tide line of the west bank of the Sacramento River; **THE TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING;** thence continuing along the last mentioned course, South 34° 55' East 20 feet; more or less; thence Northeasterly along a line parallel with and 20 feet distant from said mean high tide line of the West bank of the Sacramento River, 1269 feet, more or less, to a point which bears South 35° 49' 30" East, 110 feet, more or less, from centerline station 128+00 of said County Road No. 140; thence North 35° 49' 30" West, 20 feet, more or less, to said mean high tide line of the West bank of the Sacramento River; thence in a Southwesterly direction along said mean high tide line 1270 feet, more or less, to the true point of beginning; containing approximately 0.6 acre.
