RIGHT-OF-ENTRY PERMIT

APPLICANT: Department of Public Works, Division of Highways
LOCATION: Section 36, T. 15 S., R. 3 E., S.B.M., San Diego County
PROPOSED USE: Right-of-way for Interstate Highway 8
TERM: Initial period: 6 months, from February 29, 1968
CONSIDERATION: To be market value of land upon sale of property to the Division of Highways

The State Division of Highways has made application to purchase a parcel of State school lands for right-of-way for Interstate Highway 8, between San Diego, California, and Yuma, Arizona. The Division of Highways has requested a six-month right-of-entry permit, pending a staff appraisal and completion of the sale.

EXHIBIT "A"

That portion of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 36, T. 15 S., R. 3 E., S.B.M., according to United States Government Survey approved September 21, 1875, lying northeasterly and easterly of the following described line:

Beginning at a point distant North 29° 10' 43" West 1124.13 feet from a found 10 inch by 10 inch by 16 inch granite stone set in a rock mound, accepted as marking the NW corner of said Section 36 as set by original Government Survey and referenced by San Diego County Road Survey No. 631 on file in the Office of the County Engineer of said County, thence along the following numbered courses: (One) from a tangent that bears South 67° 40' 00" East along a curve to the right concave southwesterly with a radius 3,150 feet through a central angle of 36° 00' 00" an arc distance of 1,979.20 feet to a non-tangent line; thence (two) along said line South 23° 50' 12" East 1,045.50 feet to the point of termination distant North 24° 31' 42" East 4,241.93 feet from the southwest corner of said Section 36 marked by a 2 inch iron pipe with wood plug set in a rock mound set for the original corner of said Government Survey and referenced by said Road Survey No. 631, containing 6.95 acres more or less.

The bearings and distances used in the above description are on the California Coordinate System, Zone 6. Multiply all distances used in the above description by 1.0001922 to obtain ground level distances.
