9. PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT, SOVEREIGN LAND, SAN JOAQUIN RIVER, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY; STATE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES - W.O. N-0101, P.R.C. 3903.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 38 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT

APPLICANT: State Department of Water Resources

LOCATION: A 20-x 50-foot parcel of sovereign land in San Joaquin River at Blind Point, Contra Costa County

PROPOSED USE: The erection of a water-quality surveillance station

TERM: 8 years, from January 8, 1968

CONSIDERATION: No charge (the public benefit)

PREREQUISITE ITEMS:
U.S.A. Corps of Engineers Permit is being processed
Applicant is lessee or permittee of upland

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

The facility will be used to determine the chloride content of water at Blind Point, which will be a factor in limiting the State's upstream diversions of water.

EXHIBIT "A"

Description

W.O. NO101

Department of Water Resources

All that certain tide and submerged land in the San Joaquin River adjacent to Jersey Island, Contra Costa County, within a 20 foot strip of land lying 10 feet on each side of the following described line:

COMMENCING at U.S.E.D. triangulation station "Blume" 1931, being a standard brass cap stamped with Blom and Blume, having coordinates $Y = 136,895.72$ and $X = 2,080,574.10$, thence South $6^{\circ} 00'$ East, 3,550 feet to a point having coordinates $Y = 133,362.47$ and $X = 2,080,946.85$, said point being the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence from said true point of beginning North $6^{\circ} 00'$ West, 50 feet to a point in the San Joaquin River, containing 0.011 acre more or less.

Coordinates, bearings and distances in the above description are based on the California Coordinate System, Zone II.
