6. DREDGING PERMIT, SUBMERGED LANDS, THREE MILE SLOUGH, SACRAMENTO COUNTY;
TOM M. HESS, INC. - W.O. 6926, P.R.C. 3928.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 53 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES THE ISSUANCE OF A PERMIT TO TOM M. HESS, INC., TO DREDGE APPROXIMATELY 28,000 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL FROM AN AREA OF STATE-OWNED SUBMERGED LANDS IN THREE MILE SLOUGH, SACRAMENTO COUNTY, AS SHOWN ON EXHIBIT "A" ON FILE IN THE OFFICE OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF, AND TO PLACE THE MATERIAL BELOW THE LOW WATER LINE ALONG THE BANKS OF THE SLOUGH AT AREAS TO BE DETERMINED BY THE ADJACENT RECLAMATION DISTRICTS.

DREDGING PERMIT

APPLICANT: Tom M. Hess, Inc.
LOCATION: Submerged lands, Three Mile Slough, Sacramento County
PURPOSE: To allow barges, transporting material from dredged tailings located near Rio Vista, to pass through Three Mile Slough enroute to freeway construction site at Stockton

AMOUNT TO BE DREDGED:
Approximately 28,000 cubic yards

DISPOSITION OF DREDGED MATERIAL:
To be placed below the low water line along the banks of the slough as approved by the local reclamation districts

CONSIDERATION: The public benefit

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:
Improvement of navigation and strengthening of flood control levees

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:
Public Resources Code: Division 6, Section 6303

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- a. Project has been endorsed by the Corps of Engineers, Division of Highways, and County agencies involved.
- b. Comments have been received from the following State agencies:
 1. Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board has no objection.
 2. Department of Parks and Recreation has stated that dredging could be detrimental to stability of banks; however, applicant has stated (and received approval from Reclamation Board) that material is to be used to improve stability thereof.
 3. Reclamation Board has approved and issued Reclamation Board Order 6046 pertaining to proposed work.

4. Department of Fish and Game has no objection provided that the appropriate sections of the Fish and Game Code and other statutes relating to pollution are complied with.
 5. Department of Water Resources has no objection.
