16. AMENDMENT OF AUTHORITY TO ISSUE A PERMIT FOR PLACEMENT OF BUOYS ON STATE-OWNED LAND IN MONTEREY BAY, SANTA CRUZ COUNTY; SANTA CRUZ YACHT CLUB, INC. - W.O. 6611, P.R.C. 3897.1.

AMENDMENT OF AUTHORITY TO ISSUE A PERMIT FOR PLACEMENT OF

APPLICANT: Santa Cruz Yacht Club, Inc.

LOCATION: Monterey Bay, offshore from Santa Cruz, Santa Cruz County

TERMS: Initial period as authorized: 5 years, from January 26, 1968
Initial period as now requested: 1 year, from January 26, 1968

CONSIDERATION: \$100 total for 1 year in lieu of \$500 for 5 years

PREREQUISITE ITEM:

U.S.A. Corps of Engineers Permit issued
