After consideration of Calendar Item 54 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES THE ISSUANCE OF A PERMIT TO THE NATIONAL STEEL AND SHIPBUILDING COMPANY TO DREDGE APPROXIMATELY 120,000 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL FROM AN AREA OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS IN SAN DIEGO BAY, SAN DIEGO COUNTY, DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

STARTING AT A POINT 300 FEET NORTH 56° 51' 00" WEST OF STATION 479 ON THE U.S. PIERHEAD LINE, THENCE 340 FEET NORTH 56° 51' 00" WEST ALONG THE U.S. PIERHEAD LINE, THENCE 320 FEET NORTH 22° 47' 51" EAST, THENCE 348.18 FEET NORTH 70° 47' 51" EAST, THENCE 113.16 FEET SOUTH 19° 12' 09" EAST, THENCE 530 FEET SOUTH 22° 47' 51" WEST, ALL BEARINGS ON OLD TOWN COORDINATE SYSTEM.

THE DREDGED MATERIAL IS TO BE DISPOSED OF IN THE PACIFIC OCEAN NEAR LATITUDE 32° 37' 30" NORTH, LONGITUDE 117° 12' 00" WEST.
