9. COMMERCIAL LEASE, SUBMERGED LAND IN LAKE TAHOE, PLACER COUNTY; HELEN T. ALRICH - W.O. 6643, P.R.C. 3953.1.

After consideration of Calendar Item 3 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES THE ISSUANCE TO HELEN T. ALRICH OF A 5-YEAR COMMERCIAL LEASE FROM NOVEMBER 8, 1967, IN CONSIDERATION OF ANNUAL RENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$150 AND THE PROVISION OF A \$5,000 PERFORMANCE AND SURETY BOND AND PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE IN THE AMOUNTS OF \$100,000/\$300,000 FOR PERSONAL INJURY AND \$5,000 FOR PROPERTY DAMAGE, FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A BREAK-WATER AND MARINE FUELING STATION ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF, WITH LESSEE'S RIGHT TO RENEW FOR THREE ADDITIONAL PERIODS OF TEN YEARS EACH UPON SUCH REASONABLE TERMS AND CONDITIONS AS THE STATE MIGHT IMPOSE; PROVIDED THAT LESSEE SHALL EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT TO HOLD HARMLESS THE STATE AGAINST ALL ADVERSE CLAIMS ARISING FROM EXERCISE OF THE LEASE; AND, FURTHER, THAT THE LEASE SHALL TERMINATE SHOULD A COURT FIND THAT LEGAL RIGHTS OF OTHERS ARE INTERFERED WITH BY USE OF THE DEMISE PREMISES.

## OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

During the negotiation of this transaction several questions arose pertaining to applicant's property rights in the adjacent upland. While these questions were resolved to staff's satisfaction for purposes of leasing the affected submerged land, it was decided to require adequate protection of the State's interests. Accordingly, the applicant has executed an agreement to indemnify and hold harmless the State against adverse actions arising from the lease. Also, it has been agreed that the lease shall terminate if a court finds that lessee's use of the leased premises interferes with the legal rights of others.
