42. DEFERMENT OF DRILLING REQUIREMENTS, P.R.C. 3033.1, ORANGE COUNTY; UNION OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA - W.O. 7011.

After consideration of Calendar Item 44 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES THE GRANTING TO UNION OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA A DEFERMENT OF DRILLING REQUIREMENTS UNDER OIL AND GAS LEASE P.R.C. 3033.1 THROUGH DECEMBER 24, 1968; ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE LEASE TO REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

WORK COMPLETED ON LEASE:

Constructed platform EVA, drilled thirty-two wells; thirty wells currently producing; currently conducting seismic survey

PREVIOUS DEFERMENTS:

From July 12, 1966, through June 24, 1968

THIS DEFERMENT:

From June 25, 1968, through December 24, 1968

REASON FOR REQUEST:

To continue reservoir engineering studies and to evaluate the results of the seismic survey currently in progress
