After consideration of Calendar Item 30 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES THE ISSUANCE TO JOSEPH R. MAGINNIS OF A 49-YEAR INDUSTRIAL LEASE FROM AUGUST 1, 1968, IN CONSIDERATION OF ANNUAL RENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,401.30, WITH STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT TO REVIEW AND RESET A REASONABLE RENTAL ON EACH FIFTH ANNIVERSARY OF THE LEASE, PROVISION OF A \$20,000 SURETY BOND AND PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE IN THE AMOUNTS OF \$200,000/\$600,600 FOR PERSONAL INJURY AND \$100,000 FOR PROPERTY DAMAGE, FOR CONSTRUCTION AND OPERATION OF A PIER ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

INDUSTRIAL LEASE

APPLICANT: Joseph R. Maginnis

LOCATION: A 5.19-acre parcel of tide and submerged land in Humboldt Bay near Fairhaven, Humboldt County

PROPOSED USE: The construction of a pier to be used for the loading of lumber products for water transport

TERMS: 49 years, from August 1, 1968 Surety bond: \$20,000; Public liability ins.: \$200,000/\$500,000 for personal injury and \$100,000 for property damage

CONSIDERATION: \$1,401.30 per annum during the first five years of the lesse period, with State reserving the right to review the rental on each fifth anniversary of the lease

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION: 6% of appraised value of land

PREREQUISITE ITEMS:
