

24. AMENDMENT TO EASEMENT LEASE P.R.C. 3980.1, SUISUN BAY, SOLANO COUNTY;  
STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA - W.O. 7149.

## AMENDMENT OF EASEMENT LEASE P.R.C. 3980.1

APPLICANT: Standard Oil Company of California

LOCATION: State Oil and Gas Lease P.R.C. 3743.1, near Ryer Island in Suisun Bay, Solano County

PROPOSED USE: Applicant proposes to drill an exploratory well directionally from State Lease P.R.C. 3743.1 to privately owned land on Ryer Island which is under lease to applicant.

On June 19, 1968, W.O. 7018 (Minute Item 20, page 708), the Commission authorized the issuance to Standard Oil Company of California of a lease for a one-year term beginning June 18, 1968, to drill through and underlying a parcel of land described in Exhibit "A" of that item (page 709).

Because of unsatisfactory bottom conditions, the drilling barge has to be moved to the south of the easement area, requiring an enlargement of Easement Lease P.R.C. 3980.1.

EXHIBIT "A"

Those certain tide and submerged lands situate in the County of Solano, State of California, described as follows:

Beginning at the most southeasterly corner of State PRC 3980.1 Easement, said corner being the intersection of the most southerly line of said Easement with the southwest shore line of Ryer Island (swamp and overflowed land survey No. 611); thence, from said point of beginning, west, along the southerly line of said Easement, 1400 feet; thence south 1700 feet; thence east 1500 feet, more or less, to the shore line on the southwest shore of Ryer Island; thence in a northwesterly direction along the shore of Ryer Island to the point of beginning.
