REORGANIZATION PLAN NO. 1 OF 1968 -

COORDINATION OF STATE LANDS DIVISION WITH THE RESOURCES AGENCY

Pursuant to the Governor's Reorganization Plan No. 1 of 1968, which became effective September 14, 1968, the State Lands Division and Commission are now included in the organization chart for the Resources Agency (Exhibit "A").

Through prior discussions the Chairman of the State Lands Commission and the Secretary for Resources arrived at the following agreements relative to the reassignment.

The Reorganization Plan will make no change in:

- 1. The existent Commission policy and administrative authorities.
- 2. The existent authorities in the State Lands Division.
- 3. The existent Commission-Division relationships.
- 4. The State Lands Division will be shown on the organization chart (for the Resources Agency) as a separately reporting unit to the Agency.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE ACCEPTANCE OF THESE AGREEMENTS RELATIVE TO THE ORGANIZATIONAL REASSIGNMENTS PURSUANT TO REORGANIZATION PLAN NO. 1 OF 1968.
