

4. AMENDMENT OF AUTHORITY TO ISSUE TWO PUBLIC AGENCY PERMITS, P.R.C. 3782.9 AND P.R.C. 3783.9, TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND, SACRAMENTO RIVER IN HORSESHOE BEND, SAN JOAQUIN RIVER AT SHERMAN ISLAND, SACRAMENTO COUNTY, FOR EXPERIMENTAL FISH RELEASE STATIONS; STATE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES - W.O. 6574, W.O. 6575.

After consideration of Calendar Item 1 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION AMENDS ITS RESOLUTIONS OF JUNE 22, 1967 (MINUTE ITEMS 9 AND 10, PAGES 575 AND 578), TO PROVIDE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF TWO PUBLIC AGENCY PERMITS TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF WATER RESOURCES, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC BENEFIT, FOR OPERATION OF FISH RELEASE STATIONS ON THE LAND DESCRIBED IN SAID RESOLUTIONS, AMENDING TERM OF PERMITS FROM ONE YEAR TO FIVE YEARS, COMMENCING APRIL 1, 1967.

AMENDMENT OF AUTHORITY TO ISSUE TWO PUBLIC AGENCY PERMITS,

- APPLICANT: State Department of Water Resources
- LOCATION: Two 50- x 200-foot strips of tide and submerged land, one in Sacramento River in Horseshoe Bend, and the other in San Joaquin River at Sherman Island, both Sacramento County
- LAND USE: The operation of experimental fish release stations
- TERM AS PREVIOUSLY AUTHORIZED:  
1 year from April 1, 1967
- TERM AS AUTHORIZED BY THIS AMENDMENT:  
5 years from April 1, 1967
- CONSIDERATION: No charge (the public benefit)
- STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:
- a. Public Resources Code: Div. 6, Pt. 2, Ch. 1, Secs. 6501-6509
  - b. Administrative Code: Title 2, Div. 3, Secs. 2000-2011

- OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:
- 1. On June 22, 1967 (Minute Items 9 and 10, pages 575 and 578), the Commission authorized issuance of the above-described permits, and they were sent to the permittee for acceptance. However, inadvertently they have been held without execution since July 28, 1967. During the ensuing period it was found that the program for releasing small fish underwater to reduce predation loss was successful, and the Department has accordingly requested that the permits be extended until 1972.
