

9. PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT, TIDE LANDS, VICINITY OF POINT SAL, SANTA BARBARA COUNTY, IN CONNECTION WITH MISSILE OPERATIONS AT VANDENBERG AIR FORCE BASE; UNITED STATES OF AMERICA - W.O. 7034, P.R.C. 4077.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 39 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES THE ISSUANCE TO THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA OF AN AGREEMENT CONVEYING A LIMITED LEASEHOLD INTEREST, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE NATIONAL DEFENSE, ON THE LAND DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

TRACT 426: ALL THE TIDELANDS OF THE PACIFIC OCEAN SITUATE IN THE VICINITY OF THAT CERTAIN PROMONTORY OF LAND KNOWN AS POINT SAL, IN THE COUNTY OF SANTA BARBARA, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, EXTENDING ALONG THE COASTLINE OF SAID STATE FROM A PROMONTORY OF LAND KNOWN AS MUSSEL ROCK GENERALLY SOUTHERLY TO A POINT OPPOSITE THE SOUTHERLY END OF LOT 3 OF SECTION 2, TOWNSHIP 9 NORTH, RANGE 36 WEST, SAN BERNARDINO MERIDIAN, CONTAINING 15.00 ACRES MORE OR LESS.

PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT

APPLICANT: United States of America

LOCATION: A coastal strip of tide lands in the vicinity of Point Sal, Santa Barbara County

PROPOSED USE: A limited leasehold interest for the purpose of vacating the area for intermittent periods not exceeding 12 hours in duration in connection with missile operations at Vandenberg Air Force Base

TERMS: Initial period: 5 years, from July 1, 1968, to June 30, 1973

CONSIDERATION: No charge (in the interest of national defense)

A similar permit, P.R.C. 3005.9, was issued August 31, 1962, when the government agreed to dismissal of a condemnation action. The permit expired June 30, 1968. The government has requested a new permit for an additional five-year period.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE TO THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA OF AN AGREEMENT CONVEYING A LIMITED LEASEHOLD INTEREST, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE NATIONAL DEFENSE, ON THE LAND DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

TRACT 426: All the tidelands of the Pacific Ocean situate in the vicinity of that certain promontory of land known as Point Sal, in the County of Santa Barbara, State of California, extending along the coastline of said State from a promontory of land known as Mussel Rock generally southerly to a point opposite the southerly end of Lot 3 of Section 2, Township 9 North, Range 36 West, San Bernardino Meridian, containing 15.00 acres more or less.
