

22. GEOLOGICAL SURVEY PERMIT, OFFSHORE AREA LYING BETWEEN DEL NORTE AND SAN DIEGO COUNTIES; CONTINENTAL OIL COMPANY - W.O. 7197, P.R.C. 4104.1.

After consideration of Calendar Item 19 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES THE ISSUANCE TO CONTINENTAL OIL COMPANY OF A GEOLOGICAL SURVEY PERMIT ON TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION LYING BETWEEN THE NORTHERN BOUNDARY AND THE SOUTHERN BOUNDARY OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA, FOR THE PERIOD NOVEMBER 21, 1968, THROUGH MAY 20, 1969. APPLICATION FOR GEOLOGICAL SURVEY PERMIT

APPLICANT: Continental Oil Company

LOCATION: The offshore area lying between the northern boundary and the southern boundary of the State of California

METHOD OF EXPLORATION: Core-hole drilling

TERM: From November 21, 1968, through May 20, 1969
