

36. DEFERMENT OF DRILLING REQUIREMENTS, P.R.C. 2205.1, NAPLES OFFSHORE,
SANTA BARBARA COUNTY; PHILLIPS PETROLEUM COMPANY, PAULEY PETROLEUM INC., ET AL. -

WORK COMPLETED ON LEASE: Drilled eleven wells; four wells completed and produced; last production in December 1966. Drilled a total of 99,498 feet of hole. All wells have been plugged and the lease restored to the original condition.

PREVIOUS DEFERMENTS: From June 22, 1961, through December 21, 1968

THIS DEFERMENT: From December 22, 1968, through June 21, 1969

REASON FOR REQUEST: Quitclaim of the lease was submitted to the State Lands Commission on July 24, 1968. The operator is at present waiting for execution of court approval by the Administrator of the Estate of Paul Appleby, expected within the next 60 days.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE GRANTING TO PHILLIPS PETROLEUM COMPANY OF A DEFERMENT OF DRILLING REQUIREMENTS UNDER OIL AND GAS LEASE P.R.C. 2205.1 THROUGH JUNE 21, 1969; ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE LEASE TO REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.
