8. 49-YEAR PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT, SUBMERGED LAND OF AMERICAN RIVER IN SACRAMENTO COUNTY, FOR INSTALLATION AND OPERATION OF AN ELECTRICAL TRANSMISSION LINE; SACRAMENTO MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT - W.O. N-0147, P.R.C. 4156.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 6 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES THE ISSUANCE TO SACRAMENTO MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF A 49-YEAR PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT FROM APRIL 1, 1968, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 10151 AND 12808 OF THE PUBLIC UTILITIES CODE, FOR INSTALLATION OF ELECTRICAL TRANSMISSION LINES ACROSS THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT

APPLICANT: Sacramento Municipal Utility District

LOCATION: 1.8 acres of submerged land in American River 1000 feet west of Elvas Freeway, Sacramento County

PROPOSED USE: The installation and operation of a 230 KV electrical transmission line

TERM: 49 years, from April 1, 1968

CONSIDERATION: No charge, pursuant to Sections 10151 and 12808 of the Public Utilities Code. The rental value is estimated to be \$1,620 per annum.

PREREQUISITE ITEM:

Applicant has rights of way across adjacent uplands

EXHIBIT "A"

A parcel of submerged land lying in the bed of the American River adjacent to Section 68, as said section is shown on the "Plat of Survey and Subdivision of Rancho Del Paso" as recorded in the Office of the County Recorder of Sacramento County in Book A of Surveys, Map 94, and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at the point of intersection of the east right-of-way line of the Central Pacific Railroad with the low water line of the American River, said point having coordinates  $X = 2,157,548.34$ , and  $Y = 337,194.87$  of the California Coordinate System, Zone II, said point also being the point of beginning of a boundary line agreement between the State of California and Robert Swanston, et al., as recorded in Book 1677 of Official Records, page 69; thence along said agreed line the following courses:

- 1) S.  $88^{\circ} 16' 05''$  E. - 94.92 feet
- 2) S.  $66^{\circ} 09' 35''$  E. - 349.69 feet; thence leaving said agreed

line and along the following courses:

- 1) N.  $71^{\circ} 36' 50''$  W. - 348 feet
- 2) N.  $81^{\circ} 13' 20''$  W. - 1137.62 feet to a point on the bank of

the American River; thence along the bank of the American River the following courses:

- 1) N.  $70^{\circ} 58' 40''$  E. - 3.44 feet
- 2) S.  $88^{\circ} 07' 11''$  E. - 149.08 feet
- 3) N.  $70^{\circ} 37' 47''$  E. - 120.81 feet
- 4) S.  $83^{\circ} 47' 25''$  E. - 371.95 feet
- 5) S.  $65^{\circ} 08' 40''$  E. - 356.70 feet
- 6) N.  $63^{\circ} 27' 25''$  E. - 110.26 feet more or less to the point

of beginning, and containing 1.8 acres more or less.

EXCEPTING therefrom any land lying above the ordinary low water mark.
