29. DEFERMENT OF DRILLING REQUIREMENTS, OIL & GAS LEASE P.R.C. 2199.1, GAVIOTA AREA, SANTA BARBARA COUNTY; STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA AND SHELL OIL COMPANY - W.O. 7245.

After consideration of Calendar Item 35 attached, and upon motion duly made and unanimously carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES THE GRANTING TO STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, WESTERN OPERATIONS, INC., OF A DEFERMENT OF DRILLING REQUIREMENTS UNDER OIL AND GAS LEASE P.R.C. 2199.1 THROUGH OCTOBER 4, 1969; ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE LEASE TO REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

P.R.C.: 2199.1

LESSEE: Standard Oil Company of California and Shell Oil Company

OPERATOR: Standard Oil Company of California, Western Operations, Inc.

COUNTY: Santa Barbara

AREA: Gaviota

ISSUED: July 25, 1958

WORK COMPLETED ON LEASE: Ten wells drilled, three from upland drillsites and seven from a mobile drilling barge. Several seismic surveys conducted.

PREVIOUS DEFERMENTS: From October 5, 1962, through April 4, 1969

THIS DEFERMENT: From April 5, 1969, through October 4, 1969

REASON FOR REQUEST: To continue evaluation of production data and seismic data in order to estimate requirements for the development of Caliente structure in the southern portion of the lease

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE GRANTING TO STANDARD OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA, WESTERN OPERATIONS, INC., OF A DEFERMENT OF DRILLING REQUIREMENTS UNDER OIL AND GAS LEASE P.R.C. 2199.1 THROUGH OCTOBER 4, 1969; ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE LEASE TO REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.
