

4. TEN-YEAR PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT, SUBMERGED LAND IN EMERALD BAY, LAKE TAHOE, EL DORADO COUNTY, FOR BOTTOMING OF 16 DRUM BUOYS; STATE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION - W-8470, P.R.C. 4257.9.

PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT

APPLICANT: State Department of Parks and Recreation.

LOCATION: A 0.115-acre parcel of submerged land in Emerald Bay, at Emerald Bay State Park, Lake Tahoe, El Dorado County.

LAND USE: The bottoming of 16 drum buoys to control navigation of boats adjacent to the beach.

TERM: 10 years, from June 25, 1969.

CONSIDERATION: The public safety. No charge.

PREREQUISITE ITEMS:

U. S. Army Corps of Engineers permit issued.
Applicant is owner of upland.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:

- a. Public Resources Code: Div. 6, Pt. 2, Ch. 1, Secs. 6501-6509.
- b. Administrative Code: Title 2, Div. 3, Arts. 1 & 2, as amended effective May 10, 1969.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$138.
2. A nonmonetary permit is justified in this case by the State's responsibility to contribute to the public safety at this location.
3. This replaces an expired permit, P.R.C. 2415.9.
