29. DEFERMENT OF DRILLING REQUIREMENTS, LEASE P.R.C. 3413.1, HUNTINGTON BEACH OFFSHORE AREA, ORANGE COUNTY; UNION OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA.

After consideration of Calendar Item 27 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES THE GRANTING TO UNION OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA OF A DEFERMENT OF DRILLING REQUIREMENTS UNDER OIL AND GAS LEASE P.R.C. 3413.1 THROUGH FEBRUARY 17, 1970; ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE LEASE TO REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.

DEFERMENT OF DRILLING REQUIREMENTS
P.R.C. 3413.1.

LESSEE: Union Oil Company of California.
COUNTY: Orange.
AREA: Huntington Beach offshore.
ISSUED: A portion of State Oil and Gas Lease P.R.C. 3177.1, issued to Signal Oil and Gas Company on August 18, 1964, was assigned as P.R.C. 3413.1 to Union Oil Company of California on December 1, 1965.

WORK COMPLETED ON LEASE:

Seven producing wells drilled from platform "Eva" located on the adjacent lease.

PREVIOUS DEFERMENTS: From August 18, 1967, through August 17, 1969.

THIS DEFERMENT: From August 18, 1969, through February 17, 1970.

REASON FOR REQUEST: To continue evaluation of the performance of the wells with the view of determining the reservoir characteristics and secondary recovery potential.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE GRANTING TO UNION OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA OF A DEFERMENT OF DRILLING REQUIREMENTS UNDER OIL AND GAS LEASE P.R.C. 3413.1 THROUGH FEBRUARY 17, 1970; ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE LEASE TO REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.
