38. DREDGING PERMIT, GRANTED LANDS IN SAN FRANCISCO BAY, TO PROVIDE LADEN VESSEL CLEARANCE; BETHLEHEM STEEL CORPORATION - W-7301, P.R.C. 4290.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 37 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES THE ISSUANCE TO BETHLEHEM STEEL CORPORATION OF A PERMIT, EFFECTIVE JULY 31, 1969, THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 1972, TO DREDGE 350,000 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL, WITHOUT PAYMENT OF ROYALTY, FROM AN AREA OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND IN SAN FRANCISCO BAY, AS DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF, WITH 100,000 CUBIC YARDS OF THE DREDGED MATERIAL TO BE DISPOSED OF AT THE PUBLIC DUMPING GROUNDS SOUTH OF ALCATRAZ ISLAND IN SAN FRANCISCO BAY, AND 250,000 CUBIC YARDS TO BE DISPOSED OF AT SEA APPROXIMATELY ONE AND ONE-HALF MILES WEST OF SAN FRANCISCO IN APPROVED DUMPING GROUNDS.

DREDGING PERMIT

APPLICANT: Bethlehem Steel Corporation.

LOCATION: San Francisco Bay.

TYPE OF LANDS: Granted; all minerals reserved.

PURPOSE: Laden Vessel clearance.

AMOUNT TO BE DREDGED:
350,000 cubic yards.

DISPOSITION OF DREDGED MATERIAL:
Spoiled as follows:

1. 100,000 c.y. at public dumping grounds south of Alcatraz Island.
2. 250,000 c.y. $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles west of Cliff House, San Francisco.

CONSIDERATION: Facilitation of major ship repair operations.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. Dredge area is on lands leased to applicant by San Francisco Port Authority.
2. Department of the Army has issued a Letter of Permission effective through December 31, 1972.
3. San Francisco Bay Conservation and Development Commission has issued a permit effective through January 1, 1970, extendable for six-month periods.
4. The following State agencies have approved the proposed work:

San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board.
Department of Fish and Game
Department of Water Resources.
5. The State Department of Parks and Recreation has examined and approved the proposed project, pursuant to Section 681.8 of the Public Resources Code.

EXHIBIT "A"

A parcel of sovereign land lying in the City and County of San Francisco, State of California, more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING at the point of intersection of the east line of Illinois Street with the former south line of 18th Street; thence east along said south line of 18th Street 1,320 feet; thence south 433 feet; thence east 274.1 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence the following courses:

N. 04° 54' E. 1,071.7 feet

S. 85° 06' E. 406 feet

S. 04° 54' W. 1,037 feet

West 407.5 feet to the true point of beginning of this description, and containing 9.7 acres more or less.

The basis of bearings of this description is the former south line of 18th Street; this bearing is taken to be east.
