This conveyance is made for the purposes of a freeway and adjacent frontage roads and the grantor hereby releases and relinquishes to the grantee any and ali abutter's rights, including access rights, appurtenant to grantor's remaining property, in and to said freeway; provided, however, that such remaining property shall abut upon and have access to said frontage roads which will be connected to the freevay only at such points as may be established by public authority. The construction of said frontage roads may be deferred and said remaining property will have no access in and to said freeway except as herein provided. Grantee shall have no obligation to provide any other access to said remaining property or maintain the frontage road areas until the frontage roads are constructed and accepted for maintenance by a public agency.
