8. RIGHT-OF-WAY, T&S LAND ACROSS TURNER CUT BETWEEN ROBERTS ISLAND AND MC DONALD TRACT, SAN JOAQUIN COUNTY, FOR SUBMARINE TELEPHONE CABLE; THE PACIFIC TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY - N-0363, P.R.C. 4299.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 2 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES ISSUANCE TO THE PACIFIC TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY OF A RIGHT-OF-WAY, PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 7901 OF THE PUBLIC UTILITIES CODE, FOR INSTALLATION OF A SUBMARINE CABLE ON LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A", WHICH IS ON FILE IN THE OFFICE OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

RIGHT-OF-WAY

APPLICANT: The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company.

LOCATION: A 40-x 400-foot (approximate) strip of tide and submerged land across Turner Cut between Roberts Island and McDonald Tract, San Joaquin County.

LAND USE: The installation and operation of a submarine telephone cable.

CONSIDERATION: Exempt as to duration and consideration by Section 7901, Public Utilities Code.

PREREQUISITE ITEMS:
U.S.A. Corps of Engineers Permit issued.
Applicant is lessee or permittee of upland.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:
