8. FIVE-YEAR USE PERMIT FOR AN EXISTING PIER, SUBMERGED LAND IN LAKE TAHOE AT LAKE FOREST, PLACER COUNTY; SISTERS OF SAINT DOMINIC, CONGREGATION OF THE MOST HOLY NAME, A CALIFORNIA CORPORATION - W-8592, P.R.C. 4379.1.

USE PERMIT

APPLICANT: Sisters of Saint Dominic, Congregation of the Most Holy Name,  
a California Corporation.

LOCATION: Approximately 2,452 sq. ft. of submerged land in Lake Tahoe at  
Lake Forest, Placer County.

LAND USE: An existing pier.

TERMS: 5 years, from January 20, 1969.

CONSIDERATION: \$75 per annum.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:  
\$75 fixed rental for this type of permit.

Applicant is owner of upland.

A parcel of submerged land in the bed of Lake Tahoe, Placer County, California, said parcel being immediately below a proposed pier, being immediately adjacent to the following described land:

Lot 1, Block 13, Tahoe Island Park, as said lot and block are shown upon that certain map entitled "Tahoe Island Park", filed May 23, 1912 in Book "C" of Maps, Page 60, in the office of the Placer County Recorder, TOGETHER WITH the area of necessary use.
