19. DREDGING PERMIT, TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS IN CARQUINEZ STRAIT, MARTINEZ, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY; PHILLIPS PETROLEUM COMPANY - W-7345, P.R.C. 4392.1.

After consideration of Calendar Item 53 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES THE ISSUANCE TO PHILLIPS PETROLEUM COMPANY OF A PERMIT, EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 18, 1969, TO DECEMBER 31, 1971, TO DREDGE 20,000 CUBIC YARDS OF MATERIAL, AT A ROYALTY OF \$0.03 PER CUBIC YARD, FROM AN AREA OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND IN CARQUINEZ STRAIT, CONTRA COSTA COUNTY, AS DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF, WITH ALL DREDGED MATERIAL TO BE DEPOSITED ON APPLICANT'S PROPERTY AT LEAST 150 FEET LANDWARD OF APPLICANT'S PROPERTY LINE.

APPLICATION FOR DREDGING PERMIT

APPLICANT: Phillips Petroleum Company.

LOCATION: At Amarco Wharf in Carquinez Strait, Martinez, Contra Costa County.

TYPE OF LAND: Tide and submerged.

PURPOSE: Navigational improvement to permit access to pier Lease P.R.C. 3453.1.

AMOUNT: 20,000 cubic yards.

DISPOSITION OF DREDGED MATERIAL:
Upon applicant's property.

CONSIDERATION: Public benefit and applicant's agreement to \$0.03 per cubic yard royalty.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. The Corps of Engineers has stated that its approval will not be required for the operations proposed.
2. The Department of Parks and Recreation has made an examination pursuant to the provisions of Section 6818 of the Public Resources Code and reports that the project would have no effect upon any project or program of that Department and that there are no known recreational activities on littoral lands which would be adversely affected.
3. The Department of Fish and Game states that it has no objection to the request to dredge providing the spoils are deposited at least 150 feet inland from the Phillips property line as indicated on their Amarco Wharf plan.
4. The Department of Water Resources has issued a statement of nonobjection to the proposed dredging.
5. The San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board has approved the project subject to the following:
 - a. All dredging, stockpiling, construction, and operation of equipment for the work proposed should be performed so as to minimize roiling of Bay waters and to prevent timbers or floats that may be used in the work from drifting away as a threat to small craft.

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- b. If any dredged material is to be deposited as hydraulic fill, the applicant must file a report with the Board in accordance with the Board's Resolution No. 68-32.

to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence S. $29^{\circ} 29' 16''$ E.
55 feet; thence S. $35^{\circ} 00' 44''$ W. 330 feet; thence
S. $78^{\circ} 52' 03''$ W. 212.98 feet; thence N. $29^{\circ} 29' 16''$ W.
130 feet; thence N. $60^{\circ} 30' 44''$ E. 500 feet to the true
point of beginning. Containing an area of 1.64 acres, more
or less.
