52. AUTHORIZATION FOR CALIFORNIA ATTORNEY GENERAL TO ENTER INTO STIPULATED JUDGMENT ACCEPTING \$250 AS PAYMENT IN FULL FOR MINERAL RIGHTS IN A SECTION OF SCHOOL LAND SOLD PREVIOUSLY WITH A MINERAL RESERVATION; IMPERIAL COUNTY - W-503.545.

After consideration of Calendar Item 10 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

AUTHORIZATION FOR CALIFORNIA ATTORNEY GENERAL TO ENTER INTO STIPULATED JUDGMENT ACCEPTING \$250 AS PAYMENT IN FULL FOR MINERAL RIGHTS IN A SECTION OF SCHOOL LAND SOLD PREVIOUSLY WITH A MINERAL RESERVATION; IMPERIAL COUNTY - W-503.545.

In 1967, the United States of America, acting on behalf of the Secretary of the Navy, filed an action in condemnation entitled United States of America v. 4,337.14 Acres of Land, in the County of Imperial, State of California, Southern Pacific Land Company, et al., Case No. 67-212-S Civil (U.S.D.C. So. Dist.). The only State interest is in Section 36, T. 13 S., R. 11 E., S.B.B.& M. In 1960, the State sold this section of school land with a mineral reservation, and the United States is now condemning that mineral interest.

A staff engineer has investigated the possibility of mineral production in this section and has reported that from all currently available information any mineral production would have only nominal value. A value of \$250 has been recommended for the State's mineral interest.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE ATTORNEY GENERAL TO ENTER INTO AN APPROPRIATE STIPULATED JUDGMENT IN THE ABOVE ACTION WHEREBY THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION WILL ACCEPT THE SUM OF \$250 FOR ITS MINERAL INTEREST IN SECTION 36, T. 13 S., R. 11 E., S.B.B.& M., IMPERIAL COUNTY.
