The applicant, in writing, offered $\$ 50.00$ per aere for a total of $\$ 5,219.50$.
A staff appraisal indicates that the land is not suitable for cultivation without artificial irrigation and establishes the value at $\$ 50.00$ per acre for a total of $\$ 5,219.50$, the amount of fered by Highvays.

The Division of Highways has determined that it is necessary to purchase the State land in the section in order to construct a State highway.

A right-of-entry permit was issued by the Commission on September 24, 1.969
(P.R.C. 4294.9), giving Highways the right and privilege of going upon the property for the purpose of construction and protection of the public high.. way, pending consumnation of a final purchase. This right-of-entry permit will be unnecessary after patent is issued.
