LBWO 10,087 -- APPIAN WAY IMPROVEMENT.

CONDITIONS OBSERVED:

The conditions placed upon the Commission's original determination on this project have been met. The City was restricted as to the amounts of Tideland Oil Revenue to be expended for the improvements; namely, that these amounts were to be determined by a traffic study to establish the ratio of marina traffic to the total traffic using the Appian Way Bridge. The traffic study has been completed and the ratio of marina traffic has been resolved. Staff audits indicate that expenditures from Tideland Oil Revenue are in essential compliance with the Commission determinations as shown on Exhibit A. Inspection by staff engineers verifies that the completed work conforms essentially to the proposals submitted by the City of Long Beach.
