5. 25-YEAR PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT, TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS AT ENTRANCE TO CHANNEL ISLANDS HARBOR, VENTURA COUNTY; UNITED STATES COAST GUARD - W-6884, P.R.C. 4493.9.

PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT

APPLICANT: United States Coast Guard.
LOCATION: Channel Islands Harbor, County of Ventura.
LAND USE: A submarine cable to supply electric power to light a break-water.
TERM: 25 years, from January 1, 1968.
CONSIDERATION: No charge; the public safety.

PREREQUISITE ITEMS:

U.S. Army Corps of Engineers permit issued.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:

- a. Public Resources Code: Div. 6, Parts 1 and 2.
- b. Administrative Code: Title 2, Div. 3, Articles 1 & 2 as amended effective May 10, 1969.

The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$20.
