9. FIVE-YEAR USE PERMIT, SUBMERGED LAND IN THE COLORADO RIVER, SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY; ST. CLAIR AND HELEN E. MALOTTE - W-6540, P.R.C. 4496.1.

After consideration of Calendar Item 16 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES THE ISSUANCE TO ST. CLAIR AND HELEN E. MALOTTE OF A FIVE-YEAR USE PERMIT FROM MAY 10, 1969, IN CONSIDERATION OF ANNUAL RENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$75, FOR MAINTENANCE OF A WALKWAY AND FLOATING DOCK ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

USE PERMIT

APPLICANT: St. Clair and Helen E. Malotte.

LOCATION: A 1,552-square-foot parcel of submerged land in the Colorado River approximately 60 miles northeasterly of Blythe, San Bernardino County.

LAND USE: A floating boat dock.

TERM: Initial period: 5 years, from May 10, 1969.

CONSIDERATION: \$75 per annum.

BASIS FOR CONSIDERATION:

\$75 rental for this type of permit.

PREREQUISITE ITEM:

Applicant is lessee or permittee of upland.
