THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES THE ISSUANCE TO OCCIDENTAL PETROLEUM CORPORATION OF A 49-YEAR RIGHT-OF-WAY FROM AUGUST 1, 1970, IN CONSIDERATION OF ANNUAL RENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$20, WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT TO RESET A REASONABLE PENTAL ON EACH FIFTH ANNIVERSARY, PROVISION OF A \$2000 SURETY BOND, FOR CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF A NATURAL GAS PIPELINE ON THE LAND DESCRIBED ON EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

A strip of tide and submerged land 20 feet wide, lying in the bed of Middle River, San Joaquin County, California, between Roberts Island and Union Island and lying 10 feet on each side of the following described centerline:

COMMENCING at a San Joaquin County monument at the intersection of Howard Road and Borba Road in said County; thence S. 57° 50' 33" W., 2,413.80 feet to a nail and shiner at the centerline of Crocker Road in said County; thence S. 84° 14' 56" W., 1,862.83 feet; thence S. 23° 38' 14" W., 51.70 feet; thence N. 66° 21' 46" W., 804.42 feet parallel with and 10 feet northeasterly from an existing fence line; thence N. 26° 08' 26" W., 85.56 Leet; to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING thence S. '0° 10' 31" W., 303.08 feet across Middle River in said County to the end of the herein described centerline.

To the extent that same shall cross the tide and submerged land of the State of California within the bed of Middle River.
