QUITCLAIM OF OIL AND GAS LEASE
P.R.C. 4289.1

LESSEE: Standard Oil Company of California.

LOCATION: Solano County.

ACREAGE: 1937.

REASON FOR QUITCLAIM:

Since issuance of Lease P.R.C. 4289.1 on July 31, 1969, Standard has drilled two exploratory wells near the lease. Both wells were abandoned as dry holes, and Standard no longer considers the lands contained in the lease as a prospective area.

PREREQUISITE ITEMS:

- a. Quitclaim submitted by Lessee dated July 6, 1970.
- b. Compliance with terms and conditions of the lease through July 6, 1970.
