RENEWAL OF SERVICE CONTRACT FOR 1970-71

PURPOSE:

To renew contract with the Division of Mines and Geology for services of a Marine Geologist to perform the following:

- 1. Prepare maps and annotated lists of all coastal and offshore activities of private industry, universities and colleges, and Local, State and Federal Governments relating to geology and mineral resources information.
- 2. Make and submit special studies of marine geology in connection with problems before the State Lands Commission as requested by the Executive Officer and the Assistant Executive Officer Engineering.

CONTRACT TERMS: Period: July 1, 1970, through June 30, 1971. Costs not to exceed \$9,984.

FINANCING CONTRACT:

A transfer from the Salaries and Wages Account to the General Expense Account will be made to finance this contract.
