29. 49-YEAR PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT, TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS IN SAN PEDRO BAY ADJACENT TO SURFSIDE COLONY AND SUNSET BEACH, ORANGE COUNTY; U. S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS - W 9293, PRC 4551.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 27 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES THE ISSUANCE TO THE U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS OF A 49-YEAR PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT FROM NOVEMBER 19, 1970, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC BENEFIT AND SAFETY, FOR PLACEMENT OF BEACH FILL AND CONTINUING REPLENISHMENT AS NECESSARY ON A PARCEL OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND IN SAN PEDRO BAY ADJACENT TO SURFSIDE COLONY AND SUNSET BEACH, ORANGE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, BEING WITHIN THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED AREA:

EXTENDING FROM THE SOUTH JETTY OF ANAHEIM BAY HARBOR SOUTHEASTERLY TO A LINE 2,000 FEET SOUTHERLY OF AND PARALLEL TO THE PROLONGATION OF THE CENTER LINE OF WARNER AVENUE, FORMERLY LOS PATOS AVENUE, AND EXTENDING FROM THE ORDINARY HIGH WATER MARK WATERWAPD A DISTANCE OF 1,000 FEET: CONTAINING 280 ACRES MORE OR LESS.

PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT

APPLICANT: U. S. Army Corps of Engineers.

LOCATION: Arproximately 280 acres of tide and submerged lands in San Fedro Bay adjacent to Surfside and Sunset Beach in Orange County.

LAND USE: Implementation of a Federal beach erosion control project involving placement of 1,500,000 cubic yards of beach fill.

TERM: 49 years from November 19, 1970.

ST: No charge; the public benefit and safety.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:

a. Public Resources Code: Div. 6, Parts 1 and 2.

b. Administrative Code: Title 2, Div. 3, Arts, 1 & 2.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$20,800.
- 2. This permit supersedes and replaces lease P.R.C. 3062.9 (a life of structure permit) of June 1, 1965, which authorized placement of 3,000,000 cubic yards of fill at the same location.
- 3. Immediate action is needed on this request by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers in order that the sand may be in place before storms endanger homes on the uplands adjacent.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE TO THE U.S. ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS OF A 49-YEAR PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT FROM NOVEMBER 19, 1970, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC BENEFIT AND SAFETY, FOR PLACEMENT OF BEACH FILL AND CONTINUING REPLENISHMENT AS NECESSARY ON A PARCEL OF TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND IN SAN PEDRO BAY ADJACENT TO SURFSIDE COLONY AND SUNSET BEACH, ORANGE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, BLING WITHIN THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED AREA:

EXTENDING FROM THE SOUTH JETTY OF ANAHEIM BAY HARBOR SOUTHEASTERLY TO A LINE 2,000 FEET SOUTHERLY OF AND PARALLEL TO THE PROLONGATION OF THE CENTER LINE OF WARNER AVENUE, FORMERLY LOS PATOS AVENUE, AND EXTENDING FROM THE ORDINARY HIGH WATER MARK WATERWARD A DISTANCE OF 1,000 FEET: CONTAINING 280 ACRES MORE OR LESS.
