7. DEFERMENT OF DRILLING REQUIREMENTS, STATE OIL AND GAS LEASE PRC 3413.1, HUNTINGTON BEACH OFFSHORE AREA, ORANGE COUNTY; UNION OIL COMPANY OF CALIFORNIA - W 9326.

DEFERMENT OF DRILLING REQUIREMENTS
PRC 3413.1

LESSEE: Union Oil Company of California.
COUNTY: Orange.
AREA: Huntington Beach offshore.
ISSUED: A southern portion of State Oil and Gas Lease PRC 3177.1, issued to Signal Oil and Gas Company on August 18, 1964, was assigned as PRC 3413.1 to Union Oil Company of California on December 1, 1965.

WORK COMPLETED ON LEASE:
Seven wells drilled from platform "Eva" located on the adjacent lease; five wells currently producing.

PREVIOUS DEFERMENTS:
From August 18, 1967, through February 17, 1971.

THIS DEFERMENT: From February 18, 1971, through February 17, 1972.

REASON FOR REQUEST:
Pending approval by the Commission of previously submitted applications to conduct drilling operations on the lease, the operator has requested a deferment of drilling requirements.
