After consideration of Calendar Item 1 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

- 1. FINDS, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT NO. 32 ON FILE IN THE OFFICE OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF, THAT A PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT AS RECOMMENDED HEREIN WILL, NOT HAVE A SIGNIFICANT DETRIMENTAL ENVIRONMENTAL EFFECT.

TERMS:

49 years, from April 23, 1971.
