AUTGORIZAIION FOR AMENDMENT OF BOUNDARY LINE AGREEMENT BEIWIEN THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA AND INTERESTED PARTIES ALONG THE SHORE OF SANTA MONICA BAY IN THE VICINITY OF LAS IUNAS BEACH, MALIBU, LOS ANGELES COUNTY

On October 28, 1971, the State Lands Commission auth _ $^{\prime}$ _zed the execution of a boundary line agreement (BLA No. 125) between the State of California and various parties adjacent to the shoreline of Santa Monica Bay in the vicinity of Las Tunas, Malibu, Los Angeles County.

Said boundary line agreement was in conjunction with the issuance of a permit to the County of Los Angeles for construction of a groin system by the U.S. Corps of Engineers to prevent erosion (Minute Item No. 20, pp. 700-702).

It has been subsequently determined that a portion of the boundary line agreement has been previously agreed to by the State and certain parties and recorded on July 2, 1965 as document No. 4510 in Book D-2964 at page 810 et seq., Official Records in the office of the County Recorder of Los Angeles County (BLA No. 52 approved by the State Lands Commission July 28, 1964 and executed September 24, 1964).

It is therefore unnecessary to require the parties to the previous boundary agreement to execute BLA NO. 125 as a condition precedent to the latter becoming effective. The proposed amendment of Exhibit "B" to BLA No. 125 removes the requirement that said parties execute the present agre uent. Certain securjity interest holders listen in said Exhibit " $B$ " have also been deleted since it has been determined by che division that their execution should not be a requirement for the agreement becoming effective, although such interest holders may execute the agreement if they so desire. Additional parties have been added to Exhibit "B" as a result of their acquisition of interests affected by the agreement since the Commission previously considered this matter. The line being agreed to is not being changed. The office of the Attorney General has approved the amended agreement.
