APPROVAL OF SURVEY AND PLAT OF A PORTION OF MONO LAKE AND AUTHORIZATION TO FILE FOR RECORD IN MONO COUNTY

The Mono County Planning & Building Department is desirous of establishing a County park on certain State-owned lands fronting Section 19, T. 2 N., R. 26 E., M.D.M., which lands are within the historic State-owned bed of Mono Lake although situated landward of today's artificially lowered water line.

In order to determine the extent of said State-owned lands, the State Lands Division has surveyed and prepared a plat of the Mono Lake contour elevation of 6417 feet above sea level datum 1929. Said elevation was determined by State Lands Division study to be the last natural low water line of Mono Lake and therefore the ownership claim line of the State.
