26. RENEWAL OF INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT TO PROVIDE SERVICES OF A MARINE GEOLOGIST FROM JULY 1, 1973, THROUGH JUNE 30, 1974; DIVISION OF MINES AND GEOLOGY - P&C R&D.

After consideration of Calendar Item 25 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES THE EXECUTION OF AN INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT FOR THE 1973-1974 FISCAL YEAR WITH THE DIVISION OF MINES AND GEOLOGY TO FURNISH SERVICES OF A MARINE GEOLOGIST AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$11,780.

RENEWAL OF INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT

PURPOSE:

To renew interagency agreement with the Division of Mines and Geology for services of a Marine Geologist to perform the following:

1. Prepare maps and annotated lists of all coastal and offshore activities of private industry, universities and colleges, and local, State, and Federal Government relating to geology and mineral resources information.
2. Make and submit special studies of marine geology in connection with problems before the State Lands Commission, as requested by the Executive Officer; the Manager, Long Beach Operations; and the Manager, Energy and Mineral Resources Development.

CONTRACT TERMS: Period: July 1, 1973, through June 30, 1974.

Cost: Not to exceed \$11,780.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION OF AN INTERAGENCY AGREEMENT FOR THE 1973-1974 FISCAL YEAR WITH THE DIVISION OF MINES AND GEOLOGY TO FURNISH SERVICES OF A MARINE GEOLOGIST AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED \$11,780.
