

3. 10-YEAR PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT, TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND AT FARNSWORTH BANK OFF SANTA CATALINA ISLAND IN LOS ANGELES COUNTY; CALIFORNIA STATE DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME - W 20544, PRC 4795.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 1 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION:

1. FINDS THAT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT NO. 115 ON FILE IN THE OFFICE OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF, A PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT AS RECOMMENDED HEREIN WILL NOT HAVE A SIGNIFICANT DETRIMENTAL ENVIRONMENTAL EFFECT.
2. AUTHORIZES THE ISSUANCE TO THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME OF A 10-YEAR PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT FROM JULY 1, 1973, IN THE FORM OF A PERMIT ON FILE IN THE OFFICE OF THE STATE LANDS COMMISSION AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF; IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC USE AND BENEFIT, WITH STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT AT ANY TIME TO SET A MONETARY RENTAL IF THE COMMISSION FINDS SUCH ACTION TO BE IN THE STATE'S BEST INTEREST; FOR AN ECOLOGICAL RESERVE ON THE LAND DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT

APPLICANT: California State Department of Fish and Game.
LOCATION: A 23.38-acre parcel of tide and submerged land at Farnsworth Bank off Santa Catalina Island in Los Angeles County.
LAND USE: Ecological reserve for protection of purple coral, Allopora Californica.

TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE:

Initial period: 10 years, from July 1, 1973.

CONSIDERATION: The public use and benefit, with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rental if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:

- a. Public Resources Code: Div. 6, Parts 1 and 2.
- b. Administrative Code: Title 2, Div. 3, Arts. 1, 2, and 10.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

1. The annual rental value of the site is estimated to be \$1,400.
2. An environmental impact report has been prepared and circulated to affected governmental agencies. There were no adverse comments.

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EXHIBIT "A"

A strip of tide and submerged land 600 feet wide, lying in the bed of the Pacific Ocean, Los Angeles County, State of California, known as Farnsworth Bank as shown on U.S.C.&G.S. Nautical Chart No. 5112, and situated approximately 1.6 nautical miles southwesterly from Ben Weston Point, Santa Catalina Island, said strip being 300 feet on each side of the following described centerline:

COMMENCING at a standard bronze disk Triangulation Station "Slip", having California Coordinates $X = 1,317,157.43$ and $Y = 440,197.10$; thence $S 63^{\circ} 57' 44'' W$, 9931.95 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING of the herein above-mentioned centerline; thence $N 88^{\circ} 45' 14'' W$, 1696.67 feet to the end of the herein-described centerline.

This description is based on the California Coordinate System, Zone 6.
