17. PROPOSED EXPENDITURE OF TIDELAND OIL REVENUE FOR SUBSIDENCE REMEDIAL WORK, CITY OF LONG BEACH, LOS ANGELES COUNTY - W 10288.

After consideration of Calendar Item 18 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION APPROVES COSTS PROPOSED TO BE EXPENDED BY THE CITY OF LONG BEACH, INCLUDING SUBSIDENCE REMEDIAL WORK, FOR SUBSIDENCE STUDIES, PRELIMINARY ENGINEERING STUDIES, IN THE ESTIMATED AMOUNT OF \$10,000 FOR THE PERIOD FEBRUARY 6, 1974, TO JUNE 30, 1974; SUBJECT TO THE CONDITIONS THAT THE AMOUNTS, IF ANY, OF EACH OF THE ITEMS TO BE ALLOWED ULTIMATELY AS SUBSIDENCE COSTS, DEDUCTIBLE UNDER SECTION 4(d) OF CH. 138, STATUTES OF 1964, 1ST E.S., WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE COMMISSION UPON AN ENGINEERING REVIEW AND FINAL AUDIT SUBSEQUENT TO THE TIME WHEN THE WORK UNDER ANY OF THESE ITEMS IS COMPLETED, AND THAT THE WORK CONFORM IN ESSENTIAL DETAILS TO THE PLANS AND BACKGROUND MATERIAL HERETOFORE SUBMITTED TO THE COMMISSION. FURTHER, THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES THE EXECUTION OF APPROPRIATE WRITTEN INSTRUMENTS REFLECTING THE COMMISSION'S CONDITIONAL APPROVAL.

SUBSIDENCE ELEMENTS:

- a. City's Estimate: The project consists of preliminary work  
prior to the approval of the engineering  
phase of projects which contain a subsi-  
dence element.
- b. Staff Analysis: Initial study concludes that some subsi-  
dence costs are included but not necessarily  
all those estimated by the City.

COST OF THE PROJECT:

- a. City's Estimate 12/17/73: \$10,000 for the remainder of the fiscal  
year.
- b. Staff Comment: Amount for approval is recommended at  
\$10,000 in line with recent historical  
expenditures.

STATUTORY AUTHORITY:
