18. REDRILLING OF WELLS "STATE 392" J-94-B AND "STATE 392" J-62-A, HUNTINGTON BEACH FIELD, ORANGE COUNTY; SIGNAL OIL AND GAS COMPANY - E 392.1.

After consideration of Calendar Item 17 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION:

1. DETERMINES THAT AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT HAS NOT BEEN PREPARED FOR THIS ACTIVITY BECAUSE IT IS AN ONGOING PROJECT UNDER SECTION 21169 OF THE PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE AND TITLE 14, SECTION 15070, OF THE CALIFORNIA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE.
2. AUTHORIZES THE APPROVAL OF REDRILLING AND COMPLETING WELLS "STATE 392" J-94-B AND "STATE 392" J-62-A, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF EXCHANGE OIL AND GAS LEASE E 392.1, SIGNAL OIL AND GAS COMPANY, LESSEE, AND THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION.

PROPOSED REDRILL OF WELLS "STATE 392" J-94-B AND  
"STATE 392" J-62-A

LEASE: E 392.1.  
LESSEE: Signal Oil and Gas Company.  
COUNTY: Orange.  
AREA: Huntington Beach Field.

PERTINENT INFORMATION:

Signal has initiated a full-scale secondary recovery operation. Production performance clearly indicates that the program has been successful, resulting in an economic advantage to the State. In order to maintain a coordinated and uninterrupted secondary recovery development program, Signal has submitted an application to redrill wells "State 392" J-94-B and "State 392" J-62-A, as producing wells.

The proposed redrills are part of the plan for secondary recovery operations approved by the Commission on November 6, 1963 (Minute Item 21, page 9362). An environmental impact report is not required as this is an ongoing project. The proposed completion intervals in these wells will provide the best development spacing for optimum secondary response. The surface locations of these wells are on the uplands.

The proposed redrilling and completion programs have been reviewed by the Division and determined to be in accordance with good engineering practices and the rules and regulations of the Commission. The Division of Oil and Gas has approved the redrilling of these wells. The proposed wells are part of the plan of development exempted from permit requirements by the South Coast Regional Commission.
