38. APPROVAL OF HEARING CONCERNING RETROCESSION OF JURISDICTION; HAMILTON AIR FORCE BASE, MARIN COUNTY - W 20776.

After consideration of Supplemental Calendar Item 37 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION AUTHORIZES THE STATE LANDS DIVISION STAFF TO HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING PURSUANT TO GOVERNMENT CODE SECTION 113 AND THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERMINING WHETHER IT IS IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE STATE TO ACCEPT EXCLUSIVE JURISDICTION WITH THE UNITED STATES ARMY OF THE PARCELS OF LAND AT HAMILTON AIR FORCE BASE, MARIN COUNTY, CALIFORNIA, AS DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

APPROVAL OF HEARING CONCERNING RETROCESSION OF JURISDICTION;
HAMILTON AIR FORCE BASE, MARIN COUNTY

Government Code Section 113 provides for retrocession of jurisdiction by the United States of land within this State whenever the United States has requested in writing that the State accept such retrocession and the State Lands Commission, after a public hearing, has determined that the acceptance of such retrocession of exclusive jurisdiction is in the best interest of the State.

On May 14, 1974, Col. F. G. Rockwell, Jr., District Engineer of the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers, addressed a letter to Governor Reagan requesting that the State of California accept retrocession of exclusive jurisdiction of Hamilton Air Force Base.

This request by the District Engineer is pursuant to the Act of Congress, Public Law 91-511 dated 20 October 1970 (84 Stats. 1226; 10 U.S.C. 2683).

Based upon the foregoing, it is necessary that the State Lands Commission hold a public hearing to determine whether acceptance of exclusive jurisdiction of such lands is in the best interest of the State. Notice of such hearing is to be published pursuant to Section 6061 of the Government Code in the County of Marin.

PARCEL 1:

A parcel of land situate on the western shore of San Pablo Bay, T 3 N, R 6 W, MDM, County of Marin, State of California, more particularly described as follows:

COMMENCING at the southwest corner of the subdivision known as Grand View Tract, Subdivision B, said point being the intersection of the course designated as West 2685 feet and the course designated as N 03° 37' E; thence S 35° 04' W, 2864.79 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING;
