13. MODIFICATIONS OF DREDGING PERMIT PRC 4914.9, TIDE AND SUBMERGED LAND IN COYOTE CREEK, MARIN COUNTY; DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS, MARIN COUNTY - W 9607, PRC 4914.9.

After consideration of Calendar Item 11 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION:

1. DETERMINES THAT AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT HAS NOT BEEN PREPARED FOR THIS ACTIVITY AS SUCH REPORT IS NOT REQUIRED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF 2 CAL. ADM. CODE 2910.
2. AUTHORIZES THE MODIFICATION OF DREDGING PERMIT PRC 4914.9 TO PERMIT THE SPOILING OF 12,000 CUBIC YARDS (2,800 CU. YDS. STATE LANDS ORIGIN) OF THE MATERIAL TO BE DREDGED UNDER SUCH PERMIT, ON UPLANDS OWNED BY THE CITY OF MILL VALLEY, WITHOUT ROYALTY REQUIREMENTS, PROVIDING THAT ALL SUCH WORK IS CONDUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH ALL APPLICABLE PERMITS, REQUIREMENTS, RECOMMENDATIONS, OR LIMITATIONS ISSUED BY FEDERAL, STATE OR LOCAL GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES.

MODIFICATIONS OF DREDGING PERMIT PRC 4914.9

PERMITTEE: Department of Public Works, Marin County.

RESUME OF PREVIOUS ACTION:

A permit to dredge 25,000 cu. yds. from Coyote Creek Channel was issued on June 13, 1974. All work was to be conducted in accordance with State Environmental Impact Report No. 150. The spoils were to be taken to the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers approved disposal site south of Alcatraz Island.

Subsequently, the project encountered excessive bids due to the spoil disposal method (i.e. dragline to trucks, to barge to spoil site). An alternate plan was proposed which reduced total spoil volume to 14,000 cu. yds.; 12,000 cu. yds. of which were to be spoiled to an upland site and 2,000 cu. yds. to the Alcatraz site.

The new site is the abandoned Edgewood Reservoir owned by the City of Mill Valley. The reservoir is now used for sanitary land fill and will be used for a public park upon completion of filling.

Affected agencies have been contacted and have no objections to the change. The change is categorically exempt from requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act, as amended, under the provisions of California Administrative Code, Title 2, Division 3, Section 2910, Class 4 (Minor Alterations to Land).

PROPOSED MODIFICATIONS:

1. Change authorized volume of 25,000 cubic yards to 14,000 cu. yds. (4,800 cu. yds. from State-owned lands).
2. Change U. S. Army Corps of Engineers Alcatraz spoils site requirement to allow spoils of 12,000 cubic yards (2,800 cu. yds. State Lands origin) on uplands owned by the City of Mill Valley. The remaining 2,000 cu. yds. to be spoiled at the U. S. Army Corps of Engineers approved disposal site south of Alcatraz Island.

REASONS FOR MODIFICATIONS:

1. Volume reduction is due to a project revaluation wherein the State-owned lands involved in the project were reduced.

2. Spoiling of 12,000 cu. yds. at uplands site will be a cost saving factor for Marin County.

CONSIDERATION: Public interest and Mill Valley spoils site to be developed as a public park of City of Mill Valley.

OTHER PERTINENT DATA:

1. Permittee has permits for the modified project from:
 - a. U. S. Army Corps of Engineers.
 - b. Water Quality Control Board.
 - c. San Francisco Bay Conservation and Development Commission.
 - d. City of Mill Valley.
2. Department of Fish and Game has advised applicant that they will issue requirements for the work. The proposed modified permit will be made conditional to such Department's final approval and requirements.
3. The effective period of the permit, June 6, 1974 to December 31, 1977, is to remain the same.
