AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION: A 0.072-acre parcel of tide and submerged land located in the 200-foot State Channel at Huntington Harbour, Orange County.

LAND USE: Construction of a temporary cofferdam.

TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE:

Initial period: 1 year, from October 1, 1974.

Surety bond: \$5,000.
