

3. 15-YEAR PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT, SUBMERGED LAND IN BUTTE CREEK NEAR GRIDLEY, BUTTE COUNTY; CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME - W 20746, PRC 4980.

After consideration of Calendar Item 1 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION:

1. DETERMINES THAT AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT HAS BEEN PREPARED FOR THIS PROJECT AND CERTIFIED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME ON AUGUST 7, 1974.
2. CERTIFIES THAT THE INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THE ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME HAS BEEN REVIEWED AND CONSIDERED BY THE COMMISSION.
3. DETERMINES THAT THE PROJECT WILL NOT HAVE A SIGNIFICANT EFFECT ON THE ENVIRONMENT.
4. AUTHORIZES THE ISSUANCE TO THE CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME OF A 15-YEAR PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT FROM JANUARY 1, 1975; IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC USE AND BENEFIT, WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT AT ANY TIME TO SET A MONETARY RENTAL IF THE COMMISSION FINDS SUCH ACTION TO BE IN THE STATE'S BEST INTEREST; FOR THE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF FISH SCREENS; ON THE LAND DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT

APPLICANT: California Department of Fish and Game.

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

A 5.62-acre parcel and a 7.30-acre parcel of submerged land in Butte Creek near Gridley, Butte County.

LAND USE: Installation and maintenance of fish screens.

TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE:

Initial period: 15 years, from January 1, 1975.

CONSIDERATION: The public use and benefit, with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rental if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

PREREQUISITE TERMS:

Applicant is permittee of upland.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:

- a. Public Resources Code: Div. 6, Parts 1 and 2.
- b. Administrative Code: Title 2, Div. 3, Arts. 1, 2 & 10.
- c. Fish and Game Code: Section 6021.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

Pursuant to Section 15085(g), the Department of Fish and Game on August 8, 1974, filed with the Secretary for Resources (SCH 74040173) a notice of determination approving the project, determined that it will not have a significant effect on the environment, and that an environmental impact report had been prepared according to the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act of 1970, as amended.

Two parcels of submerged land lying in the bed of Butte Creek, Butte and Colusa Counties, State of California, being more particularly described as follows:

PARCEL 1:

All that portion of the north half of Section 6, T 17 N, R 1 E, MDM, as shown on the U. S. Township Plat approved January 3, 1856, lying westerly of the westerly boundary lines of the U. S. Subdivision Lots 7 and 8, and lying easterly of the easterly boundary lines of said Subdivision Lots 1 and 2.

PARCEL 2:

All that portion of the north half of Section 18, T 17 N, R 1 E, MDM, as shown on said plat, lying westerly of the westerly boundary lines of the U. S. Subdivision Lots 7 and 8 and easterly of the easterly boundary lines of said Subdivision Lots 1 and 2.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion of Parcels 1 and 2 lying landward of the ordinary low water mark.
