6. RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR INDEFINITE PERIOD, SUBMERGED LAND IN THE BED OF THE FEATHER RIVER AT OROVILLE, BUTTE COUNTY; PACIFIC TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH COMPANY - W 20724, PRC 4983.

After consideration of Calendar Item 4 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION:

RIGHT-OF-WAY

APPLICANT: Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company.

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

A 0.145-acre parcel of submerged land in the bed of the Feather River at Oroville, Butte County.

LAND USE: Installation and maintenance of submarine telephone cables.

TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE:

Initial period. Indefinite term, from January 1, 1975.

CONSIDERATION: Exempt by law (Section 7901, Public Utilities Code).

PREREQUISITE TERMS:

Applicant is permittee of upland.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:

- a. Public Resources Code: Div. 6, Parts 1 and 2.
- b. Administrative Code: Title 2, Div. 3, Arts. 1, 2 & 10.
- c. Public Utilities Code: Section 7901.

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EXHIBIT "A"

W 20724

A parcel of submerged land 20 feet wide lying in the bed of the Feather River within the City of Oroville, Butte County, State of California, and lying 10 feet on each side of the following described centerline:

COMMENCING at an iron pipe marking the northwest corner of Lot 9, Block 4, as shown on the map entitled "MAP OF THERMALITO; BUTTE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA", filed in the Office of the Recorder of said County on June 8, 1887; thence N 62° 25' 00" E, 37.91 feet along the southerly line of Grand Avenue; thence S 29° 39' 25" E, 86.11 feet; thence S 48° 33' 20" E, 249.21 feet; thence S 33° 27' 05" E, 552.22 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence S 14° 12' 45" E, 847.28 feet to a point being the end of the herein described centerline, said point bears S 66° 22' 00" W, 17.70 feet; N 22° 54' 15" W, 340.22 feet; N 12° 39' 50" W, 148.65 feet and N 11° 00' 35" W, 223.03 feet from a brass cap monument marking the intersection of the centerlines of Montgomery Street and Pine Street.

EXCEPTING THEREFROM that portion lying landward of the ordinary low water mark of the Feather River.
