4. 25-YEAR PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT, SUBMERGED LAND IN THE BED OF THE SACRAMENTO RIVER AT CORNING, TEHAMA COUNTY; CITY OF CORNING - W 20492, PRC 5001.

After consideration of Calendar Item 2 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

THE COMMISSION:

- 1. DETERMINES THAT AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT HAS NOT BEEN PREPARED FOR THIS ACTIVITY AS SUCH REPORT IS NOT REQUIRED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF PRC 21085; 14 CAL. ADM. CODE 15100, ET SEQ.; AND 2 CAL. ADM. CODE 2910(a).

AUTHORIZES THE ISSUANCE TO THE CITY OF CORNING OF A 25-YEAR PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT FROM FEBRUARY 1, 1975; IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH AND SAFETY, WITH THE STATE RESERVING THE RIGHT AT ANY TIME TO SET A MONETARY RENTAL IF THE COMMISSION FINDS SUCH ACTION TO BE IN THE STATE'S BEST INTEREST; FOR AN EXISTING WASTE DISCHARGE PIPELINE; ON THE LAND DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT "A" ATTACHED AND BY REFERENCE MADE A PART HEREOF.

PUBLIC AGENCY PERMIT

APPLICANT:

City of Corning.

AREA, TYPE LAND AND LOCATION:

A 30 $^{\circ}$ x 40 $^{\circ}$ parcel of submerged land in the bed of the Sacramento River at Corning, Tehama County.

LAND USE:

An existing waste discharge pipeline.

TERMS OF PROPOSED LEASE:

Initial period: 25 years, from February 1, 1975.

CONSIDERATION:

The public health and safety, with the State reserving the right at any time to set a monetary rental if the Commission finds such action to be in the State's best interest.

PREREQUISITE TERMS:

Applicant is lessee or permittee of upland.

STATUTORY AND OTHER REFERENCES:

a. Public Resources Code: Div. 6, Parts 1 & 2.

b. Administrative Code: Title 2, Div. 3, Arts. 1, 2 & 10.

OTHER PERTINENT INFORMATION:

- 1. The waste discharge pipe and protective structure facility was originally constructed in 1948. The Central Valley Region of the Regional Water Quality Control Board issued a permit to the City of Corning on May 24, 1974, for this facility. The permit contains a provision requiring the City of Corning to comply with all Federal Guidelines relating to waste discharge by June 30, 1977, the date the Federal Guidelines call for full compliance.
- 2. An environmental impact report is not required. This transaction is within the purview of 2 Cal. Adm. Code 2910(a) which exempts an existing structure that is in an acceptable state of repair and there is no evidence of record to show injury to adjacent property, shoreline erosion, or other types of environmental degradation.
