MONITORING OF POSSIBLE GEOLOGIC HAZARDS, LONG BEACH UNIT, WILMINGTON OIL FIELD, LOS ANGELES COUNTY.

Surveys are conducted twice each year, February and August, in the area of the Long Beach tidelands for the purpose of monitoring changes in the ground elevation. The Division staff then interprets these data. The results of the February 1975 survey substantiates the fact that no subsidence of the land surface has occurred as a result of operations in the Long Beach Unit.

A network of five seismic monitoring stations is being operated for the Long Beach Unit, under contract, by the Geophysical Laboratory of the University of Southern California. No seismic event has originated within the Long Beach Unit area in the last six-month period.

The Division will continue to report to the Commission semiannually on the results of the surveys and will advise of any significant change in the above conditions.
