8. RIGHT OF WAY; TIDE AND SUBMERGED LANDS IN LAIRD SLOUGH, SAN JOAQUIN AND TUOLUMNE RIVERS, STANISLAUS COUNTY; TURLOCK IRRIGATION DISTRICT AND MODESTO IRRIGATION DISTRICT; W 20702; PRC 5060.

After consideration of Calendar Item 6 attached, and upon motion duly made and carried, the following resolution was adopted:

2. An action was filed by the City of Ceres in the Superior Court of Stanislaus, Case No. 127485 against the Turlock Irrigation District and the Modesto Irrigation District alleging that the Environmental Impact Report (SCH 73121712) was deficient in that it failed to cite the impact of the transmission line passing in such close proximity to the City of Ceres.

At the conclusion of the trial, the Court held that the Environmental Impact Report was not deficient. Plaintiffs appealed the judgment to the Court of Appeals, 5th District, Fresno, California. The Court of Appeals held that the case was without grounds and dismissed the appeal. Plaintiffs then requested the California Supreme Court to hear the case. The Supreme Court denied the request.
